To improve students' reading achievement over the summer holidays

To combat the differential and cumulative impact of summer learning loss

To examine the effects of the programme on a cohort of students who have participated for 3 consecutive years








Yr. 5 Reading Progress – Ability Levels



Results Summary & Conclusions

- mean scale scores at post test for the Overall, Male, Female, Below, and At groups all increased
- most Ethnicity groups improved at post test; the Indian group made greater than expected progress while the "Other Pacific Peoples" group dropped – small sample with only 3 students in the group
- the Below and At ability groups gained at post test; the Well Below group made greater than expected progress however the Above group dropped – similar pattern to previous years
- all subtest mean scores improved at post test


- greater than expected progress was made by the Overall, Female, Male, Well Below, Below, and At groups
- the Above group dropped slightly at post test
- 7 Ethnicity groups made greater than expected progress; the CI Maori and Other Pacific Peoples groups both gained; the Asian and Indian groups dropped however both of these were small groups
- gains were made in 3 subtests; Paragraph Comprehension mean post test score dropped – data indicates that there were some large drops within the Below and At groups for this subtest


- the Overall, Female and Male groups all made greater than expected progress
- all Ethnicity groups made greater than expected progress except for Other Pacific Peoples however their mean scale score did improve at post test
- the Well Below, Below, and At groups made greater than expected progress; the Above group dropped
- all mean subtest scores improved

- the Overall , Female and Male groups improved at post test
- 6 Ethnicity groups gained; the Tongan and Niuean groups made greater than expected progress; the mean scale scores for the Samoan group remained the same at pre and post test; the NZ European and Other Pacific Peoples groups dropped – there were only 4 students in each group
- the Well Below group made greater than expected progress; the Below group gained; however the At and Above groups dropped – 5 students in these groups dropped between 10 and 20 points in their post test
- subtest results are not reported as STAR 7 8 tests have 6 subtests and so a direct comparison with the pretest (STAR 5 – 6 C) cannot be made

3 Year Study: South Auckland

- interested in comparing our results with Allington et al., 2011, ie. gains were achieved when the same cohort of students participated in the summer reading programme over 3 years
- tracked progress of 144 students who began the summer reading programme as Year 3 students in 2015 and who have participated for 3 consecutive summers
- students from 4 schools: Flat Bush, Finlayson Park, Koru & Southern Cross
- compared mean scale scores at point 1 (Nov. 2015) and at point 6 (Feb 2018) against average progress for Year 4 (Nov. 2015) and Year 6 (Feb 2018)
- equated this data to average months behind (estimation)



3 Year Study

- when the Nov. 2015 mean scale scores for the students who
 participated in all 3 years of the programme are compared with the
 mean scores for all the Year 3 students from Nov 2015, the 3 Year
 cohort were 0.99 months ahead of the other students
- a similar comparison was made between the 3 Year cohort and all Year 6 students participating in the programme in Feb 2018; at this point the 3 Year cohort were 2.22 months ahead of the other Year 6 students
- this suggests that the cumulative effect of the summer reading programme together with school and home is having a positive impact on student achievement
